The car has p/s, p/b, p/ant, gauge cluster and a tilt wheel. I do have the PHS. This car has 2 trim tags from the factory!

252375 is correct for ALL 1965 Catalina coupes, including 2+2's. Only in '66 did 2+2's have their own distinct VIN - 25437 for coupes, 25467 for convertibles, as the 2+2 was a separate model in 1966 only. For 1964, '65 & again in '67 the 2+2 was an option on a Catalina, hence the same model number in the VIN.

Your GTO is a bit out of my league, but the 455 engine and automatic might give you an edge with the 2+2. I wish you well on that - I know Steve is a fair guy.
